

Website Privacy Statement

Midwest Oral Surgery & Dental Implants

This website privacy statement explains how we collect, use, and protect your personal information when you visit our website. This statement applies to the website of Midwest Oral Surgery & Dental Implants, a dental clinic that provides oral and maxillofacial surgery services. By using our website, you consent to the practices described in this statement.

What information do we collect?

We collect two types of information from you when you visit our website: personal information and non-personal information.

- Personal information is information that identifies you as an individual, such as your name, email address, phone number, or payment information. We collect personal information from you when you voluntarily provide it to us, such as when you fill out a contact form, request an appointment, or make a payment online.

How do we protect your information?

We take reasonable measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We use encryption, firewalls, and other security technologies to safeguard your information when it is transmitted or stored on our servers. How do we use cookies and other tracking technologies?

Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer or device when you visit a website. They allow the website to recognize your browser and remember your preferences, settings, or actions. We use cookies and other tracking technologies, such as web beacons or pixels, to collect and analyze non-personal information about your website usage, such as the pages you visit, the time you spend, or the links you click. We use this information to improve our website, services, and user experience.
